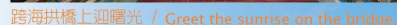


## The Interaction of Ocean Currents and Humanities

Sanxiantai, became an offshore islet due to wave erosion, formerly known as Pisirian (which means a place where people raise sheeps in the Amis language). Legend of Sanxiantai has it that the three immortals once step foot on the islet, hence the name, Sanxiantai. The Eight-arch Bridge that looks like a giant dragon Stretching across the Sea. Rugged landscape created by the marine erosion, coastal plants, and the fishing boats off the coast of Sanxiantai brings makes this place even more charming.

## 海角秘境

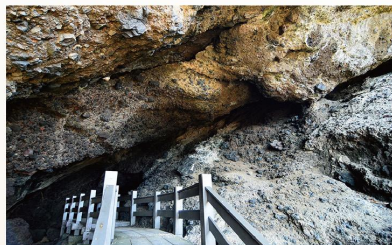
### Unexplored Headland

三仙台全島面積約22公頃，最高點約海拔77公尺，四周珊瑚礁環繞，地質屬都巒山層。由安山岩礫石與凝灰岩組成的火山集塊岩，在強烈風化、海蝕作用下，形成海蝕溝、壺穴、海蝕柱、海蝕凹壁、隧道型海蝕門等地形。

Sanxiantai islet covers an area of about 22 hectares with the highest point of 77 meters above sea level. It is surrounded by coral reefs, the geological structure of Sanxiantai is mainly formed by volcanic breccia of Du-Luan-mountain layer. The volcanic agglomerates that are composed of andesite gravel and tuff develop into a variety of land formation that includes sea-eroded trenches, potholes, stacks, caves, and wave-cut notches.

## 珍貴的原生和濱海植物

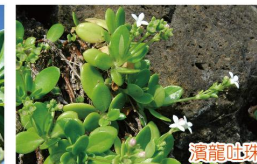
### Precious Native and Coastal Plants

三仙台島是研究海岸植物生態的重要據點，許多臺灣本島已難見到的植物，島上仍可見到它們的蹤影。除了有白水木、臺灣海棗、濱龍吐珠等國寶級的植物之外，還有臺東地區特有的臺東漆和蘭嶼木蘭。

The islet preserves a variety of rare coastal plants that are also scarce in the main island of Taiwan. Aside from the plants that are considered as National Treasure; such as *Phoenix hanceana* var. *formosana* and more. You can also find *Semecarpus gigantifolia* and *Indigofera zollingeriana* that are unique to Taitung.
